




Instructions:




Explanation:


The arrow in the first figure is rotated 180° and the arrow tail becomes the outer shape of the arrow. In the third figure, the arrow should be rotated by 180°. Since its arrow tail is a square, the outer shape in the correct answer must also be a square. Therefore, the answer is option B.




